

# To-Do List When Your Plant Arrives

## UNPACK

- Unpack your plants immediately
- Carefully remove all packing material from the soil surface
- Check each pot when it is unpacked, if the soil is dry, give it some water
- If you ordered a plant that requires high humidity move it to a plastic bag, terrarium, or humid greenhouse.
- Don't let strong sunlight shine into an enclosed container. Solar heat will heat up the container and damage your plant

## WARRANTY

We guarantee live arrival on all our plants and have a 30-day replacement on most. Please see item description for exceptions. We reserve the right to reject any claims where our receiving instructions aren't followed, or where negligence or purposeful damage has been done.

***\*If you choose to repot your plant prior to the 30-day suggested time frame, you will be voiding the warranty.***

## TRANSITION

- Place the plants in a bright area out of the wind and direct sunlight
- Remember a strong healthy root system is the most important part of your plant. **It is normal for some leaves to turn yellow and drop or break during shipment. The healthy root system will promote new growth.**

## REPOTTING

- Wait at least 30 days if you would like to repot your new plants. Only move them to one pot size larger than what they are growing in. If they are in a 4" pot transition them to a 5" or 6" pot.
- Use a loose well-draining potting mix for your new plant. Research which types of potting mix is best used for your type of plant.
